

Agriculture

- Each exhibitor is allowed to enter only one class ie: Youth, Adult Open, or Golden
- Each exhibitor is allowed one entry per division with a maximum of six entries. Only one entry **PER household** is allowed for any one division.
- All entries must be produced with current 2021 seasons produce. All entries must be fresh and not frozen or preserved in anyway.
- Entries entered in the CCAF in 2021 will not be eligible for future CCAF contests. Entries entered in previous Chattooga County Agricultural Fair competitions are not eligible for re-entry.
- All products must be produced by the exhibitor. No commercially grown products are allowed.
- Plates and display cups will be provided by CCAF. See specific classes for quantity required.
- Utmost care will be taken in displaying entries. The CCAF and associates are not responsible for mishaps or damages.
- Entries will be received only on Wednesday, August 25th, 2021 at the Chattooga County Agriculture Building between 1:00pm and 6:00pm. There are no exceptions.
- Upon registration, each contestant will be required to fill out entry tags for each entry.
- Judging will take place on August 26th, 2021 and will not be open to the public.
- 3 placings will be awarded in each category, 1,2,3 with one Grand Champion per class per the judging panel's discretion (all classes combined). One Best in Show will be awarded (all classes and divisions combined). Honorable mentions will be awarded at judging panel's discretion.
- **Any entry that does not meet the rules and regulations as specified for the category entered will not be eligible for judging and will be displayed as exhibition only.**
- Entries will remain on display at the CCAF for the duration of the fair. Any alterations or removal will result in premiums/awards forfeited and will lead to ineligibility in future CCAF contests/exhibit participation.
- Entries and premiums will be available for pick up on Monday, August 30th from 10:00am to 6:00pm. Receipt for your exhibits **MUST** accompany pick up. Any entry not picked up on August 30th, 2021 will become property of the CCAF and will be donated as the CCAF determines.

Class: One division entry allowed per exhibitor

- 1)Youth: 17 years and under
- 2)Adult Open: 18 and up
- 3)Golden: 65 and up

Divisions: Divisions A-F will be required to submit 3 examples of the same variety per class. Display plates will be provided.

- A) Peppers: Any variety
- B) Tomatoes: Any variety
- C) Cucumbers: Any variety
- D) Okra: Any variety
- E) Beans/Peas: Any variety
- F) Potatoes: Any variety
- G) Grapes: Any variety – 1 bunch will need to be entered for judging
- H) Melons: Only 1 melon will be entered for judging.
Includes, but is not limited to cantaloupes, watermelons, and honeydew
- I) Squashes: Including summer squash and zucchini varieties
- J) Pumpkins: Any variety – Only 1 pumpkin will need to be entered for judging

Farmer's Category

- K) Best four stalks of field corn
- L) Best two stalks of cotton
- M) Best two stalks of soybeans
- N) Best small square bale of Bermuda
- O) Best small square bale of fescue mix hay
