

**Chattooga County Agricultural Fair (CCAF)**  
**Blue Ribbon Contests Rules and Regulations**

**August 26<sup>th</sup> -August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

**Please read the Rules and Regulations carefully.**

**Additional rules and regulations will apply in each category, division, and class.**

- Each exhibitor is allowed to enter only one class i.e.: Youth, Adult Open, or Golden
- Each exhibitor is limited to six entries per category, with the exception of Food Preservation. (Example six total entries for Photography, six total entries for Agriculture, 6 total entries for Art) **No more than one entry per division per person.** **The exception is Food Preservation and Horticulture. Contestants are allowed to enter up to ten items in Food Preservation and Horticulture is allowed up to 14 items (no more than one per division).**
- Entries may be made by Chattooga County residents and surrounding counties of Floyd, Gordon, Walker, Dade, De Kalb and Cherokee Alabama.
- **Entries entered in the CCAF in 2021 will not be eligible for future CCAF contests.** Entries entered in previous Chattooga County Agricultural Fair competitions are not eligible for re-entry.
- Utmost care will be taken in displaying entries. The CCAF and associates are not responsible for mishaps or damages.
- Upon registration, each contestant will be required to fill out one entry tag for each entry.
- Judging will take place on August 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and will not be open to the public.
- 3 placings will be awarded in each division, 1,2,3 with a Grand Champion in each category per class at the judging panel's discretion (all divisions combined). One Best in Show per Category will be awarded (all divisions and classes combined). Honorable mentions will be awarded at judging panel's discretion. The Honey Show is exempt from this placing system and will be judged and placed according to the Welsh Honey Show Rules and Regulations. Please see the Honey Show Rules for more details.
- **Any entry that does not meet the rules and regulations as specified for the category entered will not be eligible for judging and will be displayed as exhibition only.**
- Entries will remain on display at the CCAF for the duration of the fair. Any alterations or removal will result in premiums/awards forfeited and will lead to ineligibility in future CCAF contests/exhibit participation
- Entries and premiums will be available for pick up on Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021 from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. Receipt for your exhibits **MUST** accompany pick up. Any entry not picked up on August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021 will become property of the CCAF and will be donated as the CCAF determines.
- CCAF reserves the right to refuse any entry if it found offensive or does not represent the CCAF in a positive manner. This decision is to the discretion of the CCAF Council and Blue Ribbon Committee.

**Helpful hint:**

Use personal mailing labels taped to your entry for identification. Also, bring mailing labels to affix to the tags that will be labeling your entry.
