

Needleworks

- Each exhibitor is allowed to enter only one class ie: youth, Adult Open, or Golden
- Each exhibitor is allowed one entry per division with a maximum of six entries total.
- All needlework must be original and produced by the entrant.
- Entries may be made by Chattooga County residents and surrounding counties.
- Any handiwork entered in the CCAF in 2021 will not be eligible for future CCAF contests. Entries entered in previous Chattooga County Agricultural Fair competitions are not eligible for re-entry.
- Utmost care will be taken in hanging and displaying of handiworks. The CCAF and associates are not responsible for mishaps or damages.
- Entries will be received on Monday, August 23rd, 2021 from 2:00pm to 6:00 pm and Tuesday, August 24th, 2021 from 9:00am to 1:00pm at the Chattooga County Agriculture Building. There are no exceptions.
- Names on entered pieces must not be visible. Can be covered with masking tape for judging purposes.
- Exhibitors are must have legible name and contact information somewhere on their entry.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their entries in labeled pillow cases.
- Upon registration, each contestant will be required to fill out entry tags for each entry.
- Needlework judging will take place on August 25th, 2021 and will not be open to the public.
- 3 placings will be awarded in each division, 1,2,3 with one Grand Champion per class per judge's discretion (all divisions combined in Needleworks and Quilting categories). One Best in Show will be awarded (all divisions and classes combined in Needleworks and Quilting). Honorable mentions will be awarded at judging panel's discretion.
- **Any entry that does not meet the rules and regulations as specified for the category entered will not be eligible for judging and will be displayed as exhibition only.**
- CCAF reserves the right to refuse entry if the artwork entered is offensive or does not represent the CCAF in a positive manner. This decision is to the discretion of the CCAF Council and Blue Ribbon Committee.
- Entries will remain on display at the CCAF for the duration of the fair. Any alterations or removal will result in premiums/awards forfeited and will lead to ineligibility in future CCAF contests/exhibit participation.
- Entries and premiums will be available for pick up on August 30th 2021 from 10:00 am to 6:00pm. Receipt for your exhibits **MUST** accompany pick up. Any entries not picked up on August 30th, 2021 will become property of the CCAF and will be donated as the CCAF determines.

Classes: One class entry allowed per exhibitor (Quilting has its own Division, this is an Open class Q)

1)Youth: 17 years and under;

2)Adult Open: 18 years and over

3)Golden: Age 65

Divisions:

A) Crochet:

- 1) Household items. This includes doilies, table runners, potholders, dresser scarfs etc.
- 2) Garments: Including baby wear and outer wear
- 3) Afghans and bedspreads
- 4) Scarves
- 5) Ornaments
- 6) Kitchen items
- 7) Baby Items

B) Knitting:

- 1) Household items. This includes doilies, table runners, potholders, dresser scarfs etc.
- 2) Garments: Including baby wear and outer wear
- 3) Afghans and bedspreads
- 4) Scarves
- 5) Ornaments
- 6) Kitchen items
- 7) Baby Items

C) Weaving:

- 1) Scarves
- 2) Garment
- 3) Household Items such as pillows, placemats, etc.

D) Quilting:

Class Q : There are no age categories for the quilting class. This is open to individual or team competition.

- 1) Individual: Quilt was made by only the entrant
- 2) Team: Quilt was made by 2 or more

Divisions for Quilting: This includes pieced, applique and machine quilts.

Large- Quilts – Generally 60”-110” in width and 80” or more in length

- 1) Hand Pieced/ Hand Quilted
- 2) Hand Pieced/ Machine Quilted
- 3) Machine Pieced/ Hand Quilted
- 4) Machine Pieced/ Machine Quilted

Small Quilted Item- Generally 30”-80” in width and 80” or more in length

- 1) Hand Pieced/ Hand Quilted
- 2) Hand Pieced/ Machine Quilted
- 3) Machine Pieced/ Hand Quilted
- 4) Machine Pieced/ Machine Quilted

E) Cross Stitch:

- 1) Cross-stitch -Home Decor– Includes pillow tops, decorative items, household items etc.
- 2) Cross-stitch- Wall hanging

F) Cruel Embroidery:

- 1) Cruel Embroidered Piece- Includes pillow tops, decorative items, household items etc.
- 2) Cruel Embroidered – Wall hanging

G) Sewing:

- 1) Clothing Items
- 2) Scarves
- 3) Decorative items: such as pillows, wall hangings
- 4) Dolls/Toys
- 5) Ornaments
- 6) Purses/bags
